

2016-2017 Epiphany Catholic School Spiritual Schedule

All School Masses will be celebrated every Wednesday at 2:30 pm. Pre-K students will join us the first Wednesday of the month at 8:15 am. Please have students seated in the church promptly five minutes before the start of Mass. Each month, the assigned grade will be responsible serving at the Mass: 1st reading, gift bearers, altar servers, psalmists, and concluding Monthly Prayer and Ten Commandments. Teachers and aides *must* rehearse the Liturgy with their children to ensure proper vocal responses.

We will continue the tradition of taking a collection for Hamworo School in Uganda. This is an excellent opportunity for our students to learn about sharing their treasures (monetary or prayer offerings) without expecting anything in return. Envelopes will be placed in each teacher's mailbox. Please direct any questions about envelopes or planning of the Mass to Mrs. Overby.

Mass Exceptions: The first day of school Mass will be on Thursday August 18th at 10 am.; A Mass celebrating the Feast of the Immaculate Conception will be on Thursday December 8th at 2:30 pm ; A Mass celebrating Our Lady of Guadalupe at the All School Mass on Wednesday December 14th at 2:30 pm; the end of school Mass will be on Thursday May 25th.

Confessions: Each month two grades will be scheduled for Confessions. The students in that grade should go to Confession sometime during the month. Confessions on Thursdays will be reserved for school children.

Confession Schedule:

September, December, and March: 5th Grade and 8th Grade

October, January, and April: 4th Grade and 7th Grade

November, February, and May: 3rd Grade and 6th Grade

Adoration, Rosary, Stations and Seasonal Litanies/Other Prayers: We are asking that each teacher have their class do a Rosary, Adoration and Stations of the Cross once a month. In order to make it easier for the teachers, there will be no set schedule; it will be up to each teacher to decide when they will take the students over for these special prayers. It is also important for teachers to familiarize their students of Parish and School religious arts (statuary, paintings, stained glass and sacred objects). Litanies: Teachers and staff should avail themselves of the Manual of Indulgences and recite prayers and litanies as a class.

All School Celebrations will be each month in the Church on 2nd Fridays at 2:45 pm. Please have students seated promptly at 2:45 pm. There is a single exception for Corpus Christi.
